GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. The appropriate detail should be developed by the structural engineer to fit the roof structure and the types of arrest systems to be used (i.e. Single point versus horizontal lifeline). The design shall meet OSHA 1926.502 (d) (8) and (d) (15).
2. Pitched Roofs: Assemblies shall be near the peak and spaced to meet OSHA 1926.502 subpart M, and approved by the structural engineer.

Flat Roofs: Assemblies shall be installed to meet OSHA 1926.502 subpart M and approved by the structural engineer. This assembly is usually installed on the centerline of the roof.

APPROVED MANUFACTURERS:

All materials and suppliers must be approved by the structural engineer.
